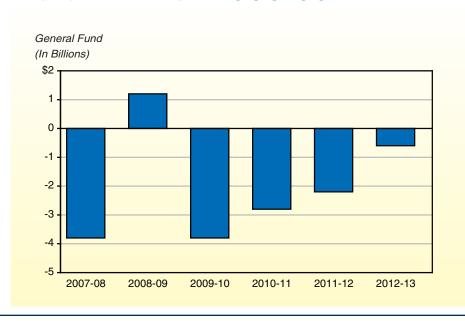


Key LAO Findings

- Balanced Budget Through 2012-13

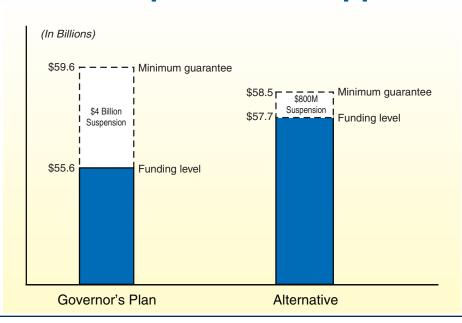


Targeted Program Reductions
