Key Elements of Mandate Reform

- Little Confidence in Mandate Determination Process
 - Revamp commission membership to address the perception of bias.
 - Assign greater fiscal and policy review responsibility to state agencies.

Lack of Payments Undermines Credibility of System

- Sunset mandates if the state does not pay promptly.
- Repeal the suspension provision—or modify it greatly.



Delays Decrease Legislative Oversight

- Require local agencies to submit clearer claims faster.
- Fund Commission on State Mandates so that it may meet its statutory deadlines.



Key Elements of Mandate Reform (Continued)

The Legislature Needs Better Information

- Create cost estimating unit to assist during legislative development.
- Inform the Legislature of mandate determination costs shortly after mandate enactment.

Claiming System Invites Problems

- Revamp and simplify mandate reimbursement procedures.
- Direct local agencies to submit all claims the year after costs are incurred.



Mandate Determinations Are Stuck in the Past

 Establish process for reconsidering mandates when legal thinking or law changes.
