Overview of Governor's Proposed 2019-20 Health Care Workforce Augmentations

Physician Residency

- University of California. Proposes \$40 million ongoing General Fund to continue funding physician residency slots that were funded on a one-time basis in 2018-19.
- Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development. Signals intent to make \$33 million in annual limited-term funding in Song-Brown primary care residency program ongoing.

Mental Health Workforce

- Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development. Proposes \$50 million one-time General Fund for mental health workforce, education, and training.
- **Department of State Hospitals.** Proposes \$1.8 million ongoing General Fund to (1) increase community college psychiatric technician training programs and (2) establish psychiatric residency programs at the Napa State Hospital.

Other Priorities

California Correctional Health Care Services. Proposes \$7.7 million General Fund over three years (\$1.8 million in 2019-20) for limited-term nurse practitioner resident positions.
