Governor. No proposal.

Senate. No proposal.

Assembly. Provide one-time cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) for state-funded portion of Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Payment (SSI/SSP) beginning January 1, 2016.

- 2015-16 Cost. \$33 million General Fund for a half-year of implementation.
- Ongoing Cost. The cost of the COLA would roughly double to around \$66 million in 2016-17 and ongoing, reflecting a full year of implementation.

^a Under current law, the SSI portion of the grant receives a federal cost-of-living adjustment each January based on the consumer price index (CPI). However, as the current estimate of the CPI for January 2016 is 0 percent, no SSI-related grant increase is anticipated in 2015-16.
